At Britestar, we are committed to providing an academically rigorous education that is firmly rooted in a Biblical worldview. We believe it is important to be open and transparent with our families about the resources we use and the topics our students may encounter.

Our curriculum includes high-quality courses, some of which present scientific and historical perspectives — such as evolution and an old-earth timeline — that do not always align with a literal Biblical account of creation and history. While these perspectives are not pervasive throughout the entirety of the curriculum, they are in our world, and we feel it is our responsibility to let parents know they are present in certain lessons and units, and why—especially in our self-paced model.

We believe it is valuable for our students to learn about different viewpoints so they can be well-prepared to think critically, engage confidently in higher education, and stand firm in their faith as they interact with the world around them. For this reason, we do not remove this content but instead supplement it with Biblical worldview notes and guiding questions before each lesson that explain the Biblical perspective and arguments against such topics like evolution and old-earth timelines.

Our goal is to help students examine all information through the lens of Scripture and to equip families to have meaningful discussions at home and their respective churches.

Our Rationale

We understand that some Christian families feel deeply concerned about exposing their children to ideas like evolution or millions of years. We respect and share your commitment to Biblical truth. *John 17:17*

While some secular viewpoints appear in certain lessons, we want to emphasize:

✓ **Biblical truth remains central.**

We intentionally weave a Biblical worldview throughout the program, so students are always encouraged to measure what they learn against Scripture. *Acts 17:11*

✓ **We equip, not endorse.**

We do not promote secular ideas as truth. Instead, we teach students how to analyze and refute them through sound apologetics and critical thinking. *1 Peter 3:15*

✓ **Your voice matters.**

Parents are encouraged to discuss lessons at home. Our Biblical worldview notes help families talk through each topic in light of Scripture. *Deuteronomy 6:6–7*

✓ **Prepared, not sheltered.**

In today's world and in higher education, students will face these ideas eventually. We believe it is wiser and safer for them to be equipped now, with truth and guidance, rather than encountering these ideas unprepared later. *Colossians 2:8*
